Please do not use the field(s) when excessively wet or muddy conditions exist. Penalties may be imposed if such usage occurs. It is the responsibility of the permittee to decide whether a field may be used. Permittee will ultimately be held responsible for this decision as well as for possible field restoration costs should a field be severely damaged.

Permittee should carry this permit to field in case of a conflict. For events at Canby Park, the Wilmington Police Department (576-3670) should be contacted. For events at all other NCCo parks, call the County Police (395-8145).

Only the Permittee, by giving the permit number, may make changes to this document through the Permit Office. It is the responsibility of the permittee to check this document thoroughly for accuracy. If something is incorrect and NCCo Permit Office is not notified, permittee will have to abide by the times(s), date(s), and location(s) as stated. **Any field maintenance problems or concerns should be immediately addressed with the permit office at 571-4006, Monday – Friday from 8am to 4pm.**

Permittee Will Be Billed For Lights ...Lighted fields are operated by a pre-set timer and **must be scheduled in advance through the permit office**. Permittee who reserves lighted time slots will be liable for such fees even in the event of non-use. Notice of light cancellation **must** be given to the Permit Office no later than 3pm Monday through Friday, by 3pm on Friday for the weekend, or by 3pm the last working day before a County holiday. FOR FACILITY EMERGENCIES (lights do not come on, lights go out unexpectedly, etc.) call Joe DiMichele, 995-6191, for Banning and Rocke Izzo, 998-6124, for Delcastle or Greenbank.

- **No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are permitted on County Parkland**
- No admission fee may be charged to spectators
- Vending in New Castle County parks without written permission from the Permit Office is prohibited.
- Often games and practices are scheduled back to back. Permittee should be courteous to other field users who are granted time slots before or after them and be on or off the field at the time stated on permit.
- Permittee agrees and warrants that it shall comply with and abide by all rules that regulated the specific activity in which it shall engage on County property.
- Football goal posts are not padded and permittee assumes related risks.
- At least one basketball court must be left open for community use.
- At least one tennis court must be left open for community use. At Banning, two courts must be left open.
- Please dispose of trash in receptacles provided. Please leave all park grounds and facilities as found.
- Violations of County Ordinances and Permit Policies are subject to prosecution and/or refusal of future usage.
- New Castle County Hold Harmless Agreement has been signed.

In accepting this permit, the applicant accepts and assumes the risk of all conditions existing in the area covered by the permit and the approaches thereto and agrees to hold the New Castle County Department of Community Services and New Castle County and their employees harmless from all risk, liability, injury, damage and loss to all persons and property, whether to the applicant, the Department of Community Services, New Castle County, or otherwise, arising out of or resulting from any use of or presence within the area covered by this permit and its approaches thereto.
